

## VOLUNTEER INTERVIEW REPORT ON LAY MINISTRIES/VOLUNTEER ROLES



*Parish communities rely on volunteers in many capacities to not only get things done, but also to make the community one in which its members feel welcomed and are proud to be part of.*

Select someone who is a *volunteer* in their parish community to interview. For example, you can meet with someone who helps at Mass (*e.g., lector, Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, altar server, music minister, minister of hospitality (i.e., usher, greeters), etc.*) or, someone who volunteers in another capacity (*e.g., Parish Office volunteer, CYO coach, PREP catechist/aide, Garden committee, Food Cupboard volunteer, special events coordination and setup, such as the Parish Festival, etc.*)...just to name a few! You are encouraged to choose a ministry or volunteer role that *you are interested in learning more about to possibly do one day!* If you need help with finding someone to talk to, please ask your teacher or the CRE.

**Note: If possible, please interview someone other than a classmate, your own teacher or your parents or siblings.**

Please write-up a summary of your interview, to include:

- † Who you interviewed and what parish they are from
- † In what capacity they serve their parish, explaining what they do and when they do it
- † Why they chose to help in this particular role
- † Why you chose to interview this person and what impact it may have on you as you think about ways that you can be of service to others

The report can be handwritten or typed and should be approximately one page in length.
