

VOLUNTEER INTERVIEW REPORT ON LAY MINISTRIES/VOLUNTEER ROLES



Parish communities rely on volunteers in many capacities to not only get things done, but also to make the community one in which its members feel welcomed and are proud to be part of.

1. Select someone who is a *volunteer* in their parish community to interview. *See attached for some examples.* You are encouraged to choose a ministry or volunteer role that *you are interested in learning more about to possibly help in one day, too!*
 - a. Please interview someone other than a classmate, your own teacher or your parents or siblings.
2. Here are some prompts to consider:
 - a. What is the name of the person you are interviewing?
 - b. Where do they volunteer and in what capacity do they serve their parish?
 - c. What do they do and when/how often do they volunteer?
 - d. How many years have they been doing this?
 - e. Why did they choose this volunteer in this area?
 - f. Why did you choose to interview this person?
 - g. How did learning more about this person's efforts motivate you to serve more?
3. Write up a summary of your interview to turn in.

You may ask the person if you can record your conversation if it is easier than taking notes while you talk with them and then write up your notes later!
