

Dear Friends,

This weekend at all Masses, everyone is invited to receive a blessing of the throat. St. Blaise was a bishop in Armenia who was martyred in the year 316 AD, and his feast day is February 3. The most popular story attributed to St. Blaise occurred while he was in prison, when he cured a young a boy who was in danger of choking to death because of a fishbone in his throat. That story, and the fact that St. Blaise was a doctor, made him very popular for intercessory prayer for throat ailments. The blessing of the throat is carried out using two white candles in an X-shape and held up to the throat of the person receiving the blessing: "Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."





La historia más popular atribuida a San Blas ocurrió mientras estaba en prisión, cuando curó a un niño que corría peligro de morir asfixiado por una espina de pescado en la garganta. Esa historia, y el hecho de que San Blas fuera médico, le hicieron muy popular para la oración de intercesión por dolencias de garganta. La bendición de la garganta se realiza con dos velas blancas en forma de X que se acercan a la garganta de la persona que recibe la bendición: "Por intercesión de San Blas, obispo y mártir, que Dios te libre de toda enfermedad de la garganta y de cualquier otra dolencia, en el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo".
