

Dear Friends,

By the time you read this letter, I hope that a good portion of the new cemetery fence has been installed. I know that it's been quite a while since we had to rebuild the retaining wall along Third Street in the new cemetery, and I thank you for your patience with the unpleasing aesthetic of the temporary fencing. The plan all along has been to replace the existing fence with a more traditional-looking cemetery one, which you can now see. The new fence is made of high-quality aluminum and mimics the traditional wrought iron fencing found in many cemeteries around the world. The coating on the fence is designed to be weather and vandalism resistant. Ultimately, all of the white picket fence will be replaced by the new aluminum fencing, giving both of our cemetery properties a nostalgic look, that is practical and easy to maintain.



Para cuando lea esta carta, espero que se haya instalado una buena parte de la nueva cerca del cementerio. Sé que ha pasado bastante tiempo desde que tuvimos que reconstruir el muro de contención a lo largo de Third Street en el nuevo cementerio, y les agradezco su paciencia con la estética desagradable de la cerca temporal. El plan desde el principio ha sido reemplazar la cerca existente con una de aspecto más tradicional, que ahora puede ver. La nueva valla está hecha de aluminio de alta calidad e imita las vallas tradicionales de hierro forjado que se encuentran en muchos cementerios de todo el mundo. El revestimiento de la cerca está diseñado para ser resistente al agua y al vandalismo. En última instancia, toda la cerca blanca será reemplazada por la nueva cerca de aluminio, lo que dará a nuestras dos propiedades del cementerio un aspecto nostálgico, práctico y fácil de mantener.


